Fadeyi, the Permanent Secretary Ministry of Budget and Economic Planning, Mrs Foluke Adebiyi, Special Adviver to Governor; Prof Babatunde Musibau, Senior Special Assistant to the governor on Economic matters, Mr OluwaseyiOgunsanya and the Chairman of Akinyele Local Government; Hon Taoheed Adedigba.

# **Roll Call of Stakeholders Present**

All the local governments were called one after the other and were asked to signify by standing for proper recognition.

The welcome address was said by the Permanent Secretary for Ministry of Budget and Economic Planning; Mrs Mofoluke Adebiyi. In her address, she emphasized that the focus of

## **Goodwill message**

The Honorable chairman, Akinyele local governments was the first to deliver a good message. # Response from the Secretary to the State Government (SSG)

She was of the opinion that all tiers of government will do their part concerning the request submitted.

She said Borehole matters will be handled by CSP, RUWASA, transformer request will be looked into while the government continues to create Mini Grid. Also, empowerment fund for PWDs and other citizens in form of soft loan will be considered by state government.

PHCCs: Personnel and facilities will be looked into and citizens will see the changes very soon.

Security: She said security is the duty of everyone and the Oyo state citizens should make use of 615-emergency number without any fear because it is anonymous.


Budget Review: She said that 2021 budget would be reviewed for performance and it would be made public.
